Drug-resistant staphylococcus infections are the second leading cause of death in hospitalized patients. The annual mortality rate of this organism is increasing. Current anti-staphylococcal therapies are severely limited and the options are often not effective. Therefore, the demand for new anti-staphylococcal agents is increasing. Here, we developed novel plant-based safe and effective phytochemicals against staphylococcal infections. A comprehensive literature search was performed for in vitro data, animal experiments and human clinical trials. The active ingredients were screened from 405 commercially available plant-derived extracts using in vitro and in vivo assays. The phytochemicals were classified by their antibacterial targets and cellular functions, and a database was constructed. The top hits were selected using integrative data analysis. Twenty-four extracts were identified and three phytochemicals were validated for their ability to inhibit staphylococcal infections. Additionally, the top hits were selected and further validated using in vivo assays. A total of 25 plant extracts and 3 phytochemicals were selected as potential anti-staphylococcal agents.
